STAR PROGRAM

The STAR Program has three (3) levels of treatment:

Level 1: Clients new to treatment and Suboxone maintenance therapy

Level 2: Clients who have been in Suboxone maintenance therapy and treatment for at least 6 months

Level 3: Clients who have been in Suboxone maintenance therapy and treatment for at least 1 year

Our staff at Crawford County Drug & Alcohol Executive Commission, Inc., are here to help you get better.

TREATMENT

While in treatment with us at Crawford County Drug & Alcohol Executive Commission, Inc., you will take steps to control your life.

You will learn about your substance use disorder and Suboxone maintenance therapy.

You will learn new, healthier ways to cope with stress, pain, and cravings.

You will join a community of individuals, professionals, and your peers who will support you.

Our treatment program is aimed at getting you to look at your addiction honestly and realistically.

YOUR SCHEDULE

We are very flexible with your scheduling needs.

For individual sessions, you will be scheduled on a bi-weekly basis.

GROUP SCHEDULE

We offer two Suboxone group sessions:

**Wednesdays at 5:15pm
Thursdays at 9:00am**

Depending on the intensity of your treatment, we can also offer other groups.

Many individuals can learn to cope with specific problems more easily if they are able to relate their frustrations, fears, and experiences with others.

The interactions and relationships within group therapy greatly enhance your rehabilitative process.
